Eligibility:

All competitors must hold a current ACU Trials Registration card or a Scottish ACU licence. Any other competitors (including Irish competitors) MUST obtain start permission from their own FMN which must confirm they are licensed by that FMN and are insured – such insurance to be sufficient to cover medical repatriation if necessary.

Entries:

To be received on the official entry form by the SECRETARY before **Saturday, 31 March 2012** together with an entry fee of:
£35.00 – solos or £43.00 - Sidecars.

PLUS 2 SELF-ADDRESSED LABELS. DO NOT SEND STAMPED SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPES

Once accepted, entry fees will only be returned if the event is cancelled.

Entries Open: **9 March 2012** Closing Date: **31 March 2012** (or when full).

Entry limit is 275 Solos and 50 Sidecars. Numbers will be allocated in order of receipt.

Marking:

The event will be marked on a "traditional non-stop basis" in accordance with TSR22B

Insurance:

ACU organised RTA cover through Doodson Motorsport will be available at signing-on.

Signing On:

To be held on Friday evening **24 August 2012** at the Villa Marina on Central Promenade, from 7pm.

Start:

The start will be at the TT Grandstand both days from 8:00am. **The use of public roads will be included in the route. It is the riders responsibility to ensure that both his machine and himself are fully legal for the purpose.**
